



## Mojitos - La Historia

The mojito was born on the island of Cuba and is one of the nation's oldest cocktails. The drink has a disputed history. Some say the drink was developed in the 1500's when the famed explorer Sir Francis Drake landed in the city of Havana, in order to sack the city of its gold. While the invasion was unsuccessful, an associate of Sir Francis Drake, named Richard Drake, created an early version of the mojito called " El Draque " out of aguardiente ( a crude form of rum,) sugar, lime, and mint. Others say the drink was invented by African slaves working in the Cuban sugar cane fields. The name " mojito " stems from the African word of " mojo " which means to place a little spell. In the mid-1800's the creation of the Bacardi company bolstered the popularity of the mojito. The mojito rose to prominence to the international world when renowned writer Ernest Hemingway became a fan of the beverage after visiting a local Cuban bar called the " La Bodeguita del Medio " and also consumed the drink in Key West, Florida. While we may never know the true origin of the drink, the tasty combination of lime and mint is sure to stick around for years to come. (Mojito pricing listed as glass/pitcher)

## CUBA LIBRE - LA HISTORIA

(made with sodas that contain 100% cane sugar)

**W**orld's second most popular drink was born in a collision between the United States and Spain. It happened during the Spanish-American War at the turn of the century when Teddy Roosevelt, the Rough Riders, and Americans in large numbers arrived in Cuba. One afternoon, a group of off-duty soldiers from the U.S. Signal Corps were gathered in a bar in Old Havana. Fausto Rodriguez, a young messenger, later recalled that Captain Russell came in and ordered Bacardi (Gold) rum and Coca-Cola on ice with a wedge of lime. The captain drank the concoction with such pleasure that it sparked the interest of the soldiers around him. They had the bartender prepare a round of the captain's drink for them. The Bacardi rum and Coke was an instant hit. As it does to this day, the drink united the crowd in a spirit of fun and good fellowship. When they ordered another round, one soldier suggested that they toast ¡Por Cuba Libre! in celebration of the newly freed Cuba. The captain raised his glass and sang out the battle cry that had inspired Cuba's victorious soldiers in the War of Independence

## CUBAN COCKTAILS

### HOTEL NACIONAL DE CUBA 10

The drink is named after the Havana hotel. This recipe was taken from a book called 'Bottom's Up' by Ted Saucier. BACARDÍ Superior rum, pineapple juice, freshly squeezed lemon juice apricot brandy

### CUBAN CARESS 10

Based on the 1940s recipe, The Cuban Caress is a delicious cocktail with a rich, fruity flavor. It was created by Crosby Gaige, a celebrated New York socialite, theatre producer and cocktail lover. BACARDÍ Superior rum, pineapple juice, Maraschino liqueur, grenadine syrup

### EL PRESIDENTE NO. 1 10

There are two El Presidente cocktails. No. 1 is a simple and satisfying mix, dating from the late 1910s and named after President Mario García Menocal who wanted a cocktail to rival the Manhattan. BACARDÍ Gold rum, sweet vermouth, Angostura® bitters, cherry and orange peel twist

### HEMINGWAY SPECIAL / PAPA DOBLE 10

This cocktail was created for Hemingway by bartender Constantino Ribalaigua of the El Floridita in Havana. Hemingway was diabetic so had the sugar in the drink replaced with Maraschino liqueur, grapefruit juice - and an additional measure of rum. **INGREDIENT** BACARDÍ Superior rum, maraschino liqueur, freshly squeezed lime juice, grapefruit juice, Maraschino cherry.

## SANGRIA

**S**angria has existed in various forms for over 2,000 years. It is believed the Romans began a practise of mixing wine with water in order to sanitise the drinking water of their expanding empire as it reached the Iberian Peninsula, where Spain and Portugal now are By the early 18th century, Sangria has spread to Latin America. It did not become a widely consumed drink in the United States of America until it was showcased at the 1964 World's fair in New York. House-made with wine, chopped fruit, fresh purees
